
# NATIONAL SMALL OIL PAINTING EXHIBITION AUGUST 26 - SEPTEMBER 21, 2016

# JUROR MICHAEL ONKEN

A juror approaching the selection phase of any exhibition in today's climate may have some cause to be wary if expecting to encounter studio practice determined to engage in relevant socio-political issues, which may require a body of text to explain how we might be expected



to respond and perhaps compensate for a predictable lack of visual satisfaction. This exhibition held a more promising prospect and delivered a full measure of satisfaction in giving pleasure when seen.

Small scale requires no compromise with regard to content, design, technical excellence or indeed the invocation of beauty. It may suggest the possibility of a more human and intimate relationship with the viewer even to the extent that it may be drawn into a physical or emotional space and linger to unfold even more pleasures over time.

That these are to be oil paintings, that messy old stuff that underpins so much of western art history, further points to certain tradition of craft, experience, patience and intent that presents less a limitation than an invitation.

My unfortunate limitation as a juror rested in the need to reduce an exceptionally large and extraordinarily worthy body of submissions to meet requirements. A half-century of looking at painting with a critical eye may provide a degree of objectivity, but subjectivity will always be a part of the process as it should be. There is work that is not here that could be, and I am left wishing that I might have just one more — and maybe another.

Michael Onken is associate professor emeritus of painting and drawing at Southern Illinois University in Carbondale. He retired in 2002 after teaching for 34 years in the School of Art and Design. Onken earned a Master of Arts degree from Northern Illinois University in 1966.
