Kyle Reicher was hired as a visiting artist at Mark Arts, then known as the Wichita Center for the Arts, in 1993. During his residence, he created an original outdoor sculpture for the Mark Arts collection. The result, Untitled (Earth House), is an open-air structure designed with trees and plants growing in the interior and with vines growing up the sides. The piece will be relocated to our new campus at 1307 N. Rock Road this fall.

Kyle Reicher, noted metal sculptor, received his BFA in sculpture from Alfred University in New York and his MFA from Wichita State University. After graduate school, Reicher spent a year in Tallin, Estonia on a Fulbright fellowship. Post Fulbright, Reicher returned to the United States and relocated to San Francisco. He found artistic representation with the Braunstein/Quay Gallery and a day job as a builder assisting ceramic artist Peter Voulkos. Reicher established connections in the art and design world and began collaborating with designers, architects, artists and builders to realize their visions in metal. After 12 years of growing a business in a glorified garage under his own name, he incorporated and became Ferrous Studios Inc. Ferrous now employs 12 talented metal artisans and boasts a fabrication shop with almost 20,000 square feet.




