I always think that my job as juror is not simply to choose an outstanding collection of individual paintings. Rather, it is my task to take a wider point of view and attempt



to assemble a show that faithfully represents the organization and the variety of visions shown by the artists who enter. Of all the things I most love and admire about the medium of watercolor is the fact that there is no one "right" way to use it. It never ceases to amaze me what disparate creations artists can bring to life on a piece of paper with a few brushes, some pigments and, of course, water. And even with such an economy of materials, watercolor is a medium that allows for the widest imaginable range of personal expression. While this makes the job of a juror more difficult, it also makes for a far more dynamic and expressive exhibition.






