She serves on the boards of directors for both the Wichita Art Museum and the Ulrich Museum of Art. She is past president of the City of Wichita Design Council and served as a public art consultant and design lead on multidisciplinary teams for the Wichita Eisenhower National Airport and Keeper of the Plains River Corridor.

CHRIS SHANK

Chris Shank grew up in an environment filled with art. His uncle was at one time a commercial artist with Western Lithograph, rubbing elbows with the Prairie Print Makers, and his aunt was a brilliant amateur artist. Chris is a commercial account executive with USI Insurance Services (formerly Dulaney Johnston and Priest), where he has worked continuously for nearly 42 years.
