Course Objectives:

Beginners can expect to learn the basics of throwing on the wheel, trimming, and glazing. For advanced students, we will work to improve skills and explore further techniques.

Course Description:

This class mixes beginning students with the experienced and ranges from the basic steps for creating functional pottery to advanced techniques for artistic sculptural vessels. Students work at their own pace in a friendly atmosphere with plenty of individual instruction.
